### **Code of Ethics followed by the institution:**

Up to 10%	Excluded	Nil	Nil
Between 10% - 40%	Level - 1	The student will be asked to resubmit the revised content within a stipulated time period which does not exceed 2 months.	He/she will be asked to withdraw the manuscript submitted for publication
Between 40% - 60%	Level - 2	The student will not be given any mark or credit and the revised script is to be resubmitted between 1 year and 18 months.	He/she will be asked to withdraw the manuscript submitted for publication and will not be allowed to publish their work for a minimum timeperiod of 2 years. He/she will also be denied any annual increment that they have been receiving. He/she will also not be allowed to act as a guide for students for 2 years.

Above 60%	Level - 3	The student will not be given any mark or credit	He/she will be asked to withdraw manuscript submitted for publication and will not be allowed to publish any work for a minimum time period of 3 years. He/she will also be denied any annual increment they are receiving for 2 years. He/she will also not be allowed to act as a guide for students for 2 years.
