ACTION TAKEN REPORT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2017-18

The IQAC is concerned with all aspects of academic and administrative performance of our college. The IQAC works towards quality enhancement through a comprehensive program that includes internalization of “Quality Culture” in all areas of our college.

- 1) IQAC assisted the departments in conducting various college activities like Inter Class & Inter Collegiate Competitions, Merit Prize Distribution, College Convocation, College Athletic Meet etc.,
- 2) The college was selected as one of the participating non-technical institution under the Unnat Bharath Abhiyan – an MHRD initiative.
- 3) The college was shortlisted for empanelment of EDP Zones under PMYUVA Scheme. As a part of this program, an Entrepreneurship Development Cell was set up in the college.
- 4) Students have enrolled for the Swachh Bharat Summer Internship program being launched by the Ministry of Human Resource Development in association with the Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Government of India.
- 5) Involved in collecting the student feedback and preparing the analysis. The IQAC convened a department wise meeting with the principal to discuss the feedback analysis of the faculty members.
- 6) All activities and events mentioned herewith were designed to enhance the quality of academics and administration in our college. The IQAC had the overall perspective in organising, planning and executing various programmes. Departmental heads and faculty members took it forward to achieve the intended goal.
- 7) To improve the Teaching Quality, Subject Oriented FDP Programmes to Staff were organised by the departments.

- 8) IQAC organized a Faculty Development Program for all Science Faculty members on "Student Centered Learning" by Dr. G K Rekha, Minnesota State Colleges and Universities System, USA,
- 9) The Calendar of Events gave us a definite road map through the year. Examinations were held as per schedule and results were announced with no delay whatsoever.
- 10) Faculty members followed their 'Lesson Plan' fastidiously and the completion of syllabus adhered to the time frame.
- 11) Scholarships, both governmental and private, were disbursed on time to the deserving students.
- 12) All the programs were documented by the Department of Journalism through the college magazine 'Vartha Vahini'.
- 13) An MOU was signed with 'Training and Research Initiatives' to provide professional counsellors on campus for students
- 14) ED Cell was inaugurated in the college, in association with Pradhan Mantri Yuva Yojana and Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, on 28th December 2017
- 15) Faculty published papers in the proceedings of various National and International conferences and workshops and UGC approved journals.
- 16) Around 200 students got placed through campus placement.
- 17) The Alumni Association – 'SAMMILANA' met on 13th January 2018. Around 400 alumni participated in the programme
- 18) The Biotechnology Alumni created an endowment – "Bhavani Memorial Fund" in the memory of their classmate Ms. Bhavani Y T, who succumbed to Cancer - for Rs.2,00,000/-. The interest earned will be used to create Cancer Awareness among the youth.
- 19) Student feedback was taken in the month of March. The Departments conducted their BOS in the month of April/May.
- 20) As an eco-friendly initiative 2 units of Leaf littered digesters were installed in the campus.


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
