

## ADMISSION POLICY

### **ADMISSION POLICY (Undergraduate and Post graduate)**

- The college has a Direct Admission Policy.
- Students to the general and vocational courses are admitted on ‘first – come – first served’ basis with a qualifying percentage of thirty-five.
- Admission strategies are governed by the rules established by the Management and the Directorate of Collegiate Education.
- Admission is granted to women only and the Govt. of Karnataka’s ‘quota’ regulations is strictly adhered to with reference to the disadvantaged community, differently-abled, economically weaker- sections, athletes and sports persons.

- As an incentive special scholarships are also given to students who come from SAI and other bodies.
- We strictly abide by the Bangalore University’s stipulations regarding the sanction of sections and the number of students per section.
- Fee structure for each course is displayed on Notice Boards
- Scholarships instituted by private individuals are extended to the deserving.
- To encourage the meritorious students, maximum 10 students in commerce, 5 students in arts and 5 students in Science who secure more than 90% in II PUC in commerce and more than 80% in Arts and Science are exempted from paying the college fees. This is purely first come and first serve basis.
- **Paying fees in installments and concessions is permitted to those who seek such a facility**
- All courses are guided by the regulations set by the Governing Council and Academic Council of the College (autonomous scheme)
