UNNAT BHARAT ABHIYAN

nnat Bharat Abhiyan" cell of the college attended the Gramsabha conducted by the Chikkanahalli Gram Panchayat at Donenahalli village on 27th August 2018. The principal, Coordinator, Faculty members of different Departments with 50 students of the college participated. The team identified the major problems of all the five adopted villages under the scheme during discussion, such as poor health care, lack of educational infrastructure, unemployment and substance abuse, and absence of proper banking facilities.

SPOTLIGHT

Varina Vahini from this issue has started a regular column 'Spotlight' which is an interview with the alumni of the College. The column attempts to highlight the achievements of many alumni who have excelled in various fields. This gives an exposure to the students as well as the other readers of Vartha Vahini about how the alumni have contributed to the growth of the institution. They are the torchbearers of the college who have projected the institutions for aeons.

This issue has an excerpt of an interview with Ms. Saraswathi Bellur, Assistant Professor, Department of Communications, University of Connecticut. A former student of Journalism, Optional English and Psychology, she graduated in the year 2000 and did her post graduation from University of Mysore and an other PG from IoWA State University, USA. She completed her doctorate from Pennsylvania State University. She has a number of research affiliations and her papers have been cited by many researchers.

Here are the excerpts:

1. Briefly tell us about your journey from NMKRV as a student of Journalism, Optional English and Psychology to being an Assistant Professor in the University of Connecticut.

I cherish the time I spent at NMKRV, getting introduced to the fields of Journalism, Optional English and Psychology. The wonderful community of amazing mentors and like-minded peers has left a lasting impression on me and my work, to this day. After my B.A., I pursued my M.A. program at Mysore University in Mass Communications. My interest in pursuing higher education in the field encouraged me to apply to an M.S. Program in Mass Communications at the Iowa State University (Iowa, USA). This was my first experience as a student in an international academic



setting, which opened up more doors in terms of pursuing social science research. The M.S. program at Iowa State further piqued my interest in studying the effects of mass media (new or digital media, in particular). This led to me pursue my doctoral (Ph.D.) program at the Pennsylvania State University (Pennsylvania, USA). After 6-years of in-depth study, in 2012, I embarked upon an academic career as an Assistant Professor at the University of Connecticut. My current research focuses on the effects of new media technologies (interactive media, electronic-health and mobile-health communication technologies) and how they affect us (both as individuals and as a society). I currently teach graduate and undergraduate courses on Computer-Mediated Communication and Mass Communication Systems.

2. As a gold medalist right from your Bachelor's degree, Postgraduate degree and various other laurels in the field of teaching communication, what were the pointers of motivation?

A primary source of motivation has been my desire to learn. In several classes that I took at NMKRV, I still distinctly remember those "Aha!" moments that come from insightful learning. Experiences like that continue to motivate me to learn, teach, share and communicate. I have been blessed with some of the best teachers, guides, and mentors, at every stage of my academic career, who have been a great source of inspiration and motivation. My cohort of classmates, and fellow "kindred-spirits", along with an extremely supportive family, have all been tremendous sources of motivation.

3. What were the factors that made you take up communication as a subject and to pursue it till the end to become an academician?

Communication encompasses every aspect of our lives, whether it is face-to-face, mass media, or newer media forms (mobile, social media, virtual reality, games, etc.). I was always fascinated with how ideas can be conveyed effectively -- both via media (channels) and via messages (content) – to influence how people feel, think and behave. This prompted me to pursue an academic career in communication and media studies.

4. Tell us about your experience as a student of journalism at NMKRV College for Women.

Studying journalism and NMKRV was an eye-opening experience at many levels. It was one of my first forays into exploring some of the fundamental theories behind communication, along with an opportunity to appreciate the practical application of journalistic practices in everyday media. Learning about the 5Ws and 1H, the SMCR model, the inverted pyramid format of news writing, reporting and editing stories for Vaartha Vaahini, understanding the importance of media laws (e.g., Article 19, freedom of speech) and its role in a democratic society...I could go on! The journalism course at NMKRV laid a solid foundation on which I could further shape my academic interests. Further, all the courses that I took at NMKRV in Journalism, Psychology and Optional English, wonderfully complemented each other. Even to this day, I rely on all three disciplines to inform and guide my work.

5. Why didn't you get into mainstream media but take up academics.

I was always fascinated with the underlying theoretical principles that shape media messages and how they affect audiences (or users). What really intrigues me is how we can apply a scientific approach to understand, explain and predict what the mainstream media do on an everyday basis. In a sense, I see mainstream media (and their products – whether it is mobile apps, websites, TV shows, publications, etc.) as my "laboratory". Whereas, my role as a social scientist, is to examine those products and measure their impact on individuals and society. I also enjoy interacting with students, teaching and learning together with the larger scholarly community of students, peers, mentors and colleagues. These factors drew me toward an academic path.

6. Your take on the present day media especially the digital media.

The world of digital media is fascinating! I think it is a very exciting time to be part of this information (digital media) economy, where all of us get to produce, consume and distribute information via communication technologies. At the same time, given its exponential growth, immense reach and potential for misuse, the field is in urgent need of people who can study its impact, systematically. Both in theory and in practice, we need to build more media literacy, where we can educate ourselves and others of the pitfalls and limitations of digital media. We need a greater understanding of how technological advancements come with inherent trade-offs, and how we can proactively protect ourselves and others from the negative effects of digital media.

7. Your advice to the present day communication students and budding students.

Never shy away from asking questions. Stay curious, strive to keep learning and having fun!


